A Call from Heaven

During the six apparitions to the three shepherd children at Fatima from May-October, 1917, Our Blessed Mother, and the Angel of Peace before her, imparted an intense call to pray and make sacrifices in reparation for sins committed against God.

Perhaps more than any time in history, we the faithful are being called upon to console Our God and turn to Him with all our hearts to heal our modern world.

“Take and drink the Body and Blood of Jesus Christ, horribly outraged by ungrateful men. Make reparation for their crimes and console your God.” (Angel of Peace, 1916)

Our Response

The World Apostolate of Fatima invites you to respond to Our Lady’s simple plan for peace in our world and in our families—a plan that transcends the ages and is hope for the future:

Prayer and penance for conversion and reparation for sins

“Sacrifice yourself for sinners and say many times... ‘Oh Jesus, it is for love of You, for the conversion of sinners, and in reparation for sins committed against the Immaculate Heart of Mary.’” (Our Lady, July 13, 1917)

Daily recitation of the Rosary

“Pray the Rosary every day in order to obtain peace for the world.”
(Our Lady, May, 13 1917)

Genuine devotion to the Eucharist

“Most Holy Trinity, I adore You! My God, my God, I love You! in the Most Blessed Sacrament.”
(Angel of Peace, 1916)

Entrustment to the Immaculate Heart of Mary

(and wearing the Brown Scapular as a sign of that consecration) *“My Immaculate Heart will be your refuge and the way that will lead you to God.”* (Our Lady, June 13, 1917)

Practice the First Five Saturdays devotion

“You have seen hell where the souls of poor sinners go. To save them, God wishes to establish devotion to my Immaculate Heart.” (Our Lady, July 13, 1917)

Hope for Today

The Catholic Church teaches that Fatima is for the whole world. Pope John Paul II exemplified that best when he entrusted the world to the Immaculate Heart of Mary in 1984.



“Do not be afraid.”
(Our Lady at Fatima)

Pope Benedict XVI referred to Mary’s message at Fatima as a sign of our hope for today: *“Although anxieties and sufferings have not been lacking, and there are still reasons for apprehension about the future of humanity, what the ‘Lady in white’ promised to the little shepherds is consoling: ‘In the end, my Immaculate Heart will triumph.’”* (Rome 2006)
